



# Limited Visitor Guidelines - Hospital

## Non-COVID-19 Patients

- 2 designated visitors during duration of inpatient stay, only 1 visitor allowed to visit at a time
  - 1 designated visitor for emergency department (adult)
  - 1 visitor for outpatient hospital department-based procedure and surgery
  - 3 visitors for end-of-life situations in a room at a time
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## COVID-19 Positive Patients or Patients Suspected of Having COVID-19

- No visitors are allowed, with few exceptions. Please see the screening station for a list of exceptions.
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## Pediatric Patients

### Pediatric Non-COVID-19 Patients

- 2 parents/caregivers at the same time for inpatient pediatrics
- 2 parents/caregivers for pediatric emergency department
- 2 parents/caregivers for NICU private rooms or 1 parent/caregiver for NICU open pod configuration

### Pediatric COVID-19 Positive or Patients Suspected of Having COVID-19

- 1 parent/caregiver for patients 21 years of age and under

### Pediatric Outpatient Departments and Outpatient Surgery

- 1 parent/caregiver for pediatric patients
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*Please note: Behavioral Health visitor guidelines are up to site discretion. All visitors and designated support people must be 18 and older. The only exceptions include: end-of-life visitation; and visitor for laboring women, when the baby's father is under 18 years old.*
