Each year, 100 Milwaukee infants die before their first birthdays -- and black infants are three times more likely to die than white infants. Infant mortality is a complex problem that takes a communitywide effort to address.

We ask you to join this work by participating in Milwaukee's annual collaboration of city leaders, health officials, and the faith community. The Strong Baby Sabbath is set for Sunday, October 13, 2019. We will again focus on the two most preventable causes of infant death in Milwaukee: premature births and unsafe sleeping environments.
