A few guidelines:

- You will have ½ of an 8-foot table to set up your Share Fair display.
- There is no access to electrical outlets.
- Please do not bring items to sell. Bring materials, ideas, resources, or even information about how to purchase a product you have developed, but this is not a venue for actively selling items.
- You are responsible for printing and transporting your own materials for the event.
- Because space at the venue is limited, you must register for the Convening so that we can count you in the overall numbers. Please register at <https://faithandresilience.eventbrite.com>.
- There is no additional charge to participate in the Share Fair.
- The Share Fair will be open during the morning registration period and during breaks and lunch. Please arrive by 7:30 a.m. so that you are set up and ready when people start arriving at 8:00 a.m. Displays must remain up and Sharers must be present at their tables through lunch.
