Our official summer program, *Summer Camp*, will begin on June 17, 2019, with regular hours from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Our goal: to provide your child with a safe environment that will include a variety of activities to aid in developing social, physical and educational skills. We provide a “family” atmosphere of learning and sharing.

Our program is set up so you can sign-up for one week, or multiple weeks. Families can sign up for one day a week or all five days! Our themes bring new and exciting things each week, so the fun keeps on going.

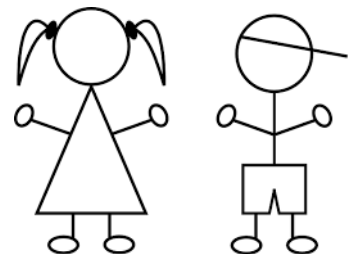
Wednesdays are field trip days. Field trip permission slips and individual costs are assessed for each trip. Trips are listed ahead of time so you can plan ahead. Friday afternoons are Meadowbrook pool play followed by the famous bagel snacks.

There are many camps available here at school throughout the summer. We are available for you before and after these camps. Please note on Wednesdays, however we do leave for field trips at 9:30 am and do not return until after 3:00 pm, so other arrangements will have to be made on those days.
