Breathing Air Quality in the Workplace

This webinar will be an introduction to industrial hygiene focusing on worker breathing zone air quality in the industrial workplace. Attendees will learn to recognize airborne conditions in the work environment that may lead to worker complaints, illness, and/or OSHA violations; to recognize operations that can produce hazardous breathing zone air for workers; to describe the basics of how air contaminants are injurious to workers; and to differentiate between particulate and vapor contaminant exposure.
