EVACUATION WARNINGS UPGRADED TO ORDERS IN SAN MATEO COUNTY

WHAT: Evacuation Orders Issued

WHEN: Effective Immediately

WHY: The National Weather Service has issued a **Flash Flood Watch** and **Wind Advisory** to the CZU Lightning Complex burn area, increasing the potential for debris flows, downed trees and power outages.

WHERE: **EVACUATION ORDERS:**

- South Coast Zone **SMC-E019**, which includes Año Nuevo State Park, Whitehouse Canyon Road and areas south of Gazos Creek Road east of Highway 1.
- South Coast Zone **SMC-E038**, which includes Butano State Park and the Community of Barranca Knolls, west of Cloverdale Road.
- The Communities of Loma Mar and Dearborn Park in Zone **SMC-E018**.
- The Community of Butano Canyon in Zone **SMC-E098**

As the morning progresses and wind and rain increase, downed trees, tree branches, and mudslides could impede evacuations. Power could be impacted. Please do not wait to evacuate.

NOTES: Half Moon Bay High School is open as a Temporary Evacuation Point (TEP)
