CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Containment continues to increase, and restoration of communities and critical infrastructure remains the priority. A thick layer of smoke will maintain cooler than normal temperatures, particularly inland, through at least Saturday. Crews continue to mop up and control hot spots throughout the fire area in an effort to support repopulation efforts. Hazards, like compromised trees still exist in the area.
