EVACUATION WARNINGS ISSUED FOR AREAS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY

WHAT: Evacuation Warnings

WHEN: Effective Immediately

WHY: The National Weather Service has issued a **Flash Flood Watch** and **Wind Advisory** for portions of the CZU Lightning Complex burn area, increasing the potential for debris flows, downed trees and power outages.

WHERE: **EVACUATION WARNINGS:**

- South Coast Zone **SMC-E019**, which includes Año Nuevo State Park, Whitehouse Canyon Road and areas south of Gazos Creek Road east of Highway 1.
- South Coast Zone **SMC-E038**, which includes Butano State Park and the Community of Barranca Knolls, west of Cloverdale Road.
- The Communities of Loma Mar and Dearborn Park in Zone **SMC-E018**.
- The Community of Butano Canyon in Zone **SMC-E098**

These areas will be upgraded to EVACUATION ORDERS at 8am Sunday, October 24, 2021. As Sunday morning progresses and winds and rain increase, downed trees, tree branches, and mudslides could impede evacuations. Power could be impacted. Please do not wait to evacuate.

NOTES: Half Moon Bay High School will open at 8am tomorrow (Sunday) as a Temporary Evacuation Point (TEP) **1 Lewis Foster Drive, Half Moon Bay, CA. 94019**
