#### **MARYLAND STEM CELL RESEARCH GRANT!**

The Maryland Stem Cell Research (<u>MSCRF</u>) Commission announced in a <u>press release</u> on May 9th that over \$14.1 million in grants were awarded to promote innovative research that will strengthen and advance stem cell treatments and technologies in Maryland, and **Alex Ksendzovsky**, **MD**, **PhD** was one of thirty-nine scientists to receive this award. Dr. Ksendzovsky along with co-investigators Drs. Philip Iffland (Assistant Professor of Neurology at UMSOM) and Seth Ament (Associate Professor of Psychiatry at UMSOM), will receive grant funding to take stem cells from genetic epilepsy patients, and use microelectrode array technology to create personalized antiepileptic therapies. *Congratulations Dr. Ksendzovsky!*
