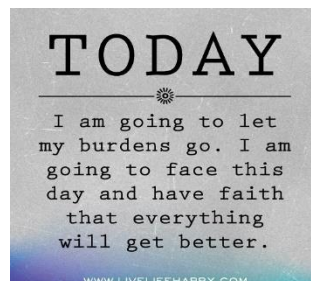

### III. Prophetic Truths and the Law of Compound Probability

- The Bible contains more than 1800 prophecies and more than 1200 in the Old Testament and more than 550 in the New Testament.
- Fulfilled prophecies are evidence of divine inspiration.
- The Bible is the only book in the world that has clear and accurate prophecies.
- There were more than 340 prophecies that were written in the old testament that were fulfilled in the new testament by 1 man- (Jesus Christ)
- Psalm 40:7- speaks of Jesus coming in the volume of the book. (The bible)
- The reason the Bible can stand as truth to the prophecy is due to the minute probability of fulfillment.
- A famous man named Dr. Stoner a professor of astronomy and mathematics; he took 8 prophecies of the Bible and used theories to try and distort the accuracy of the Bible. After his calculations he discovered that Christ fulfilled an astronomical percentage of prophecies that can only be done by 1 person without any variables. His research proved that there is no way any other person or persons can fulfill the promises of truth.
- There is a prophecy that describes the crucifixion; this is a profound truth because crucifixion was designed by Romans which did not appear until the era of the NT. How could a man predict specifics without it being divine inspiration?
- If God says it; than that settles it!
- If everything in the Bible has come to past; than what makes us think the rest of God's word is not true and won't be fulfilled?
- We must be women who believe and live by the word of God!
- We must have God's word in our hearts and spirits!
- We may not understand everything in God's word; but there is enough for us to hold true and believe.
- There was a poplar saying that said "If God says it; I believe it and that settles it" the reality is that whether you believe it or not; it is already settled!
- God said it and that settles it! We believe because God made it truth!

## IV. The Relevancy of the word
