

DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions is as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

✠ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

✠ Prayer of the Week

Blessed are you, O God, who hears our prayers of joy, of peace, and of love. Hear our prayers as we wave our palm branches and shout, "Hosanna." We are blessed because you are the one who saves us. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- ❓ **Highs & Lows:** What made you feel happy today? What made you feel sad today?
- ❓ **Thinking About This Week's Story:** The people were excited to praise Jesus as he rode a colt into Jerusalem. How did you praise God today?
- ❓ **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Surprise! The tomb is empty, and Jesus has been raised to new life. What surprised you today? How did you experience new life today?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

✠ Wave your hands in the air like palm branches and have each person say a prayer of joy.

CLOSING

✠ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

✠ Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

Mark one another with the sign of the cross on each other's hands or forehead, and say, "Go and bless others with God's love today. Amen."
