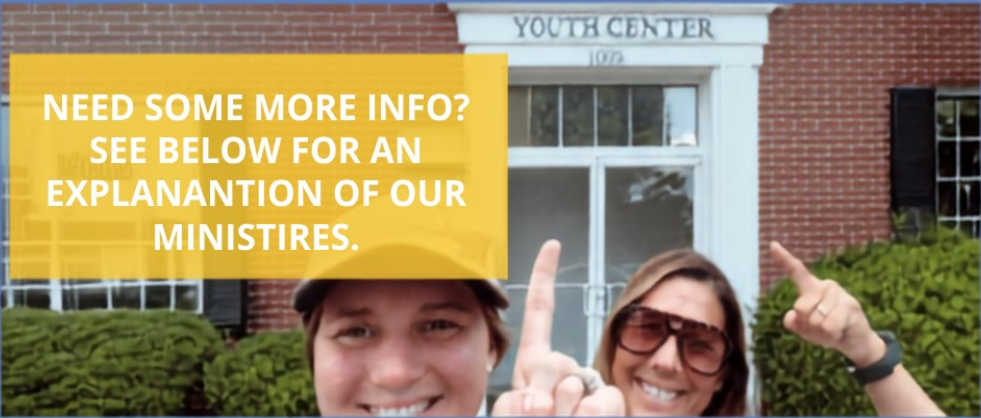

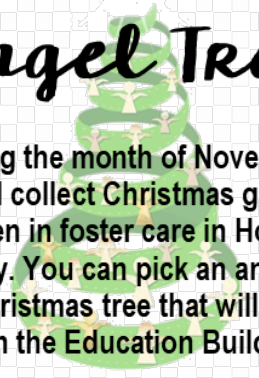

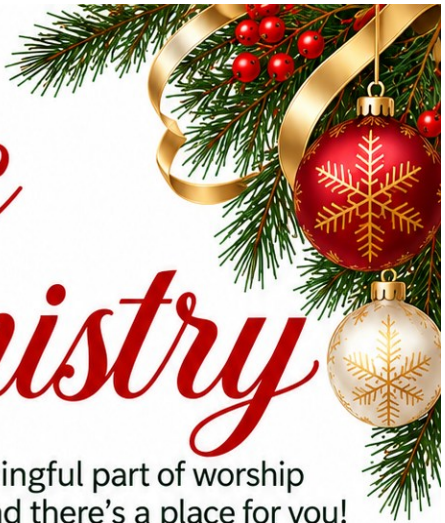

Caring Cards

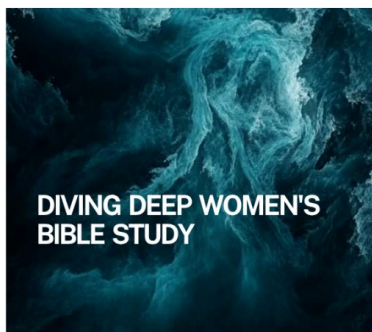

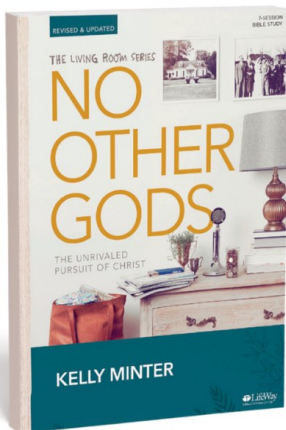
