The senior lockbox program provides emergency responders a way to gain access into the homes of participating residences. This assists in expediting access during medical or other emergencies. This is a free program for town and county residents.

Shred-a-thon: Help prevent identity theft by shredding unwanted documents and personal papers. The next Shred-a-thon will be held Tuesday, April 22 from 3 – 6 p.m. at the Christiansburg Recreation Center. This is FREE to all members of the public.
