



## COVID-19 Health Screening and Safety Rules

### ***Health Screening:***

We want to make sure that you, our Bethel Horizons staff and volunteers, and all of our guests feel safe when using our facilities. Therefore, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, you are required to confirm the following prior to attending summer camp. **Please initial the following statements to confirm that you understand and agree with the statement.**

Your camper(s)' current temperature (taken by Horizons screener) is \_\_\_\_\_

- **You have a negative molecular (PCR) test for your camper that was taken within the last 7 days.**
- Your camper(s) and all members of your household are not experiencing any of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills or repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, & runny nose or nasal congestion.
- Your camper(s) and all members of your household have not tested positive for the COVID-19 virus in the past two weeks.
- Your camper(s) and all members of your household are not currently under quarantine due to having tested positive for COVID-19 or due to having been exposed or potentially exposed to COVID-19.
- Your camper(s) and all members of your household have not had close contact with anyone confirmed to have the COVID-19 virus in the past two weeks.

**Safety Rules:**

Your camper(s) agree to abide by all government mandated safety and social distancing measures while utilizing our facilities. Without limiting the foregoing, you will also comply with the following:

- Allow one of our staff members to take your camper's temperature regularly while at camp (if your camper's temperature exceeds 100.4° F or if other COVID-19 symptoms are present, you understand that your camper will be isolated and need to be picked up from camp).
- Bethel Horizons staff will check daily with campers to ask if they are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Campers will be asked to wash their hands often, using hand washing stations or hand sanitizer provided.
- Campers will be asked to avoid close contact with others not in their small group.
  - maintaining 6 feet of distance between campers and other persons both indoors and outdoors for those outside the camper's small group.
- Wear a face covering (consistent with CDC recommendations) when in public indoor spaces and when singing at campfires.
- Follow any other safety measures that may be required by our staff members.

**If you are unable to confirm all of the above or refuse to abide by our heightened safety requirements, your camper will not be able to participate in summer camp. By signing below I confirm all of the above and agree to abide by the heightened safety requirements.**
