The **Scholarship Program** has concluded for 2017 and the results will soon be announced. Please encourage your community to apply for available scholarships in the future.

The AFA National <u>Teacher of the Year (TOY)</u> competition is concluded and the committee is considering the applicants in order to make a selection. The announcement should be made by the end of July. Thanks to those chapters that participated in the TOY program this year. Seventy-four AFA Chapters awarded Chapter Teachers of the Year; of these, 20 Chapters awarded and self-funded an additional Teacher of the Year. Twenty-eight States (including 2 overseas areas) awarded State Teachers of the Year.
