- c. Tape 25 Box Tops to a blank sheet of paper.
 - Mark sheet with your child's name and classroom number.
- 4. Here's the important part: Each Box Top must have a visible product acronym and expiration date, so don't cut/rip those parts **OR** send in expired BoxTops
