

Trading Pin Design Contest

Missouri FBLA

Overview

Missouri FBLA members and advisers have the opportunity to showcase their creativity by designing the trading pin for NLC through this contest. The winning design will become the official state trading pin for the 2024 National Leadership Conference in Orlando, FL.

Eligibility

Design is open to:

- All paid Missouri FBLA middle school, high school, or collegiate members in an active Missouri FBLA chapter. The state office will verify membership for the current school year.
- Advisers of Missouri FBLA active chapters.
- Only one pin design entry per Missouri FBLA member/adviser is permitted.

Guidelines

All entries must be submitted to Missouri FBLA exactly as directed in the rules below and become the property of Missouri FBLA once submitted. Missouri FBLA retains the right to modify the final design as necessary to produce a pin to our standards and the manufacturer's specifications.

- The following must be included in the submission: Designer's Name, Designer's Email (if a student, email must be able to receive outside emails), Chapter Name, FBLA Division, Adviser Information, and uploaded file.
- Files must be uploaded in either PDF, JPG, or PNG utilizing design software such as Illustrator, Photoshop, Canva, etc. No freehand entries will be accepted.
- Files must be in good quality to be accepted.
- The design must be rendered in full color.
- The design cannot exceed five colors. If more than five colors are used, the design will be subject to change.
- The design must incorporate the words "Missouri FBLA" and "2024."
- The design must showcase the state of Missouri in some fashion.
- The FBLA logo may be used but must follow the [Brand Guidelines](#).
- All copyright laws must be followed in the creation of the design.

Deadline

- Submissions can be submitted now [at this link](#).
- The final day to submit a pin design is Friday, March 15, 2024, at 5 PM.

Procedure

After the close of the deadline, all submissions will be narrowed down to the Top 5 to be voted on at each division's State Leadership Conference. The design with the most votes will become the official trading pin for the state at the National Leadership Conference.
