Timeframe - April 20, 2020 - Deadline May 6, 2020

Amount - \$4000 grants for U.S.recipients - \$2500 cash, \$1500 in ads credits.

Yelp & GoFundMe - Small Business Relief Fund

Together, Yelp and GoFundMe are making it easy to donate directly to the businesses they love, and support their communities. By leveraging Yelp's opt-in program, business owners can claim their GoFundMe fundraiser with the click of a button. It will be displayed on the business's Yelp page, giving more visibility to the fundraiser.

The Yelp Foundation and GoFundMe have pledged to match up to \$1 million in total donations from matching grants made possible by the Small Business Relief Fund. The Fund, managed by GoFundme.org, will make a \$500 matching grant for the first 2,000 eligible businesses that claim or otherwise start their fundraising page on GoFundMe and raise \$500.

Timeframe: March 24 until Fund is depleted.
