Summer Residence Program



Each summer, Newman invites interested students to live in our residence and participate in the life of the community while working or taking summer courses.

While living at our beautiful, centrally located heritage home, students offer 8 hours per week of volunteer service and take advantage of a reduced monthly residence fee. Duties include maintenance of drop-in spaces, liturgical support, meal set-up and clean-up for those living in residence, and assisting at the morning or evening Sunday Mass.

Our residence rooms are open to those who are working or studying in Toronto, and who are Catholics in good standing who are seeking to serve others and grow in their faith.

Residence Fees

Our residence fees are \$1000 per month, and include room and board. Lunches and suppers are catered from a local supplier, and residents have access to a communal kitchen, living room and dining room. Breakfast foods are provided for residents to prepare as they choose.

Residence rooms are single rooms with a private or semi-private bathroom, and include WiFi and access to free laundry facilities.

Volunteer Service

In exchange for reduced residence fees, your 8 hours of volunteer service is broken up into the following:

Sunday Mass duty at either the 11 am or 7 pm Mass (3 hours)

House duties, including table set-up, meal pick-up and clean up (2 hours)

Drop-in space support and administrative support, including evening clean up and lock up, as well as assistance at any evening group meetings if needed, and special projects that work specifically with your schedule (2 hours)

Bi-weekly resident meeting (30 min)

Bi-weekly prayer meeting (30 min)

Interested in Applying?

Those looking to apply for summer residence at the Newman Centre are asked to complete an application, and meet with the residence selection committee in order to determine suitability for community.

Although residents are fairly free to come and go as they please, meals, resident meetings, Mass duty, and various other aspects of residency at Newman are communal in nature. We want to ensure that those who live in the Centre are willing to engage in Newman's mission, and to take on the responsibilities of living with others in a Catholic household.
