



Business Series Train-the-Trainer

Giving you the tools to increase the supply of child care and success of family child care educators in your community!

Overview

All Our Kin (AOK) is excited to offer our Business Series Train-the-Trainer (TTT) nationally to trainers at early childhood organizations and provider associations. Participants will leave this interactive learning experience equipped to lead our Family Child Care Business Series (virtually or in-person). The Series is an engaging and accessible course for family child care educators that provides 34 hours of professional learning over a 10 week period. The AOK Business Series has been taught in more than 21 states, with participating educators experiencing an 80% increase in their business knowledge.

[Covered topics](#) include contracts, marketing, Time-Space Percentage, and more. The materials are completely translated and available in English, Spanish, and Chinese. All Our Kin provides detailed implementation guides and follow up support as trainers pilot this Series in their communities.



The cost for each participant is \$3,500.

This includes the weeklong training and box of materials, access to the curriculum in multiple languages, a quarterly community of practice for trained trainers, a trainers website and more!

Why learn from All Our Kin?

All Our Kin's model:

1. Is grounded in a strengths based and value-approach
2. Provides tools and resources for educator to grow as business leaders
3. Elevates family child care educator business practices

- Increase FCC educators' earnings and well-being

Participants & Structure

The TTT is best suited for trainers at organizations that work directly with family child care providers. Participants should have dedicated work time and resources to implement the Business Series after the training. They do not need to have extensive business knowledge, though they should be comfortable with basic math. We especially seek bilingual applicants who can offer the Business Series in Spanish in their home communities and teams of two or more participants to co-facilitate.

The next TTT will be held October 2nd - 6th, 2023, daily 11:30-5:00 EST (virtually via Zoom).
