The Battalion Chief Position

The Battalion Chief position supervises and coordinates fire suppression companies on an assigned shift or within assigned stations.

The BC position also serves as the chief field officer during emergency responses – supervising multiple companies, directing response efforts, and acting as an Engine Company Officer and/or Apparatus Operator as needed.

The BC position will manage, direct and organize major departmental programs such as training, operations, prevention, safety, facilities management, apparatus management and equipment management; provide technical and administrative staff support to the Fire Chief.

The Escalon Fire District

The Escalon Fire Protection District, formed in 1912, provides fire suppression and rescue operations around the clock to a District that covers 65 square miles of primarily agricultural land in the Southeast corner of San Joaquin County.

The Escalon Fire Protection District includes 7 full-time staff, and 14 reserve and volunteer firefighters. The District has 9 different pieces of equipment, and conducts all operations from a main fire station in downtown Escalon.
