USDA zone 7. handsome broadleaf evergreen tree from eastern Asia. Height 30-40 Feet Spread 15-20 Feet Beautiful holly like foliage, year round screen and windbreak, rounded crown like Live oak. The evergreen leaves emerge bright red in spring, shading to copper before turning glossy dark green. By summer, leaves reach 6in. long. Deep purple fruit in fall are followed by chartreuse star shaped flowers. Connoisseur tree, rarely available.
