- ✓ Can identify barriers to accomplishing education & employment goals. Examples:
 - Basic skills deficient
 - Low income, homeless, runaway
 - Offender or ex-offender
 - Foster care
 - Pregnant or parenting
 - Has a disability
 - School dropout
 - English language learner
- ✓ Eligible to work in the U.S.
- ✓ Registered for the Selective Service (if applicable)
- ✓ Actively seeking positive self-growth
- ✓ Motivated to be successful
