The United Way ALICE® Project, a grassroots movement inspired by United Ways in 18 states, will unveil national data that upends the rosy economic picture portrayed by conventional unemployment and jobs reports. The Project developed a series of groundbreaking measurements that quantify the size of who in America's workforce is struggling financially, and the reasons why. United Ways have coined the term ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) to describe the staggering number of essential American workers who are unable to afford the rising cost of necessities, as revealed by the new data. Presenters will demonstrate how policy makers, business leaders and nonprofits are collaborating on innovative solutions that fight to reduce the ranks of financially fragile working households and secure America's future economic stability.
