Blissfest Presents: The Way Down Wanderers

PETOSKEY — The Blissfest Music Organization will present The Way Down Wanderers, an alternative folk band from Chicago, to kick off the new year at the Ross Stokes Theater at the Crooked Tree Arts Center.

Blissfest Executive & Programming Director Jim Gillespie commented that "from the first time I discovered this dynamo group at the Folk Alliance music conference, I knew I had to have them for Blissfest. After 2 Blissfest festivals and a Bliss concert, they are still one of my favorite hard driven acoustic new folk wizards. Some say they are easy on the eyes. I say they are easy on the eyes and the ears."

"People love their high energy," said Dan Calloway, Blissfest Business Director. "They also have a neat local connection as they picked up their banjo player Travis Kowalsky when they headlined the Thunder Bay Folk Festival in Alpena a few years ago. Travis was there playing as a part of his family band."

Front-men and founders, Austin and Collin, met in their hometown and became friends through writing music and forming their band. Collin was only 16 and Austin was 20 at the time.

"Together they are a really tight band who have wowed crowds all over the country. We are thrilled to have them back in Northern Michigan to help stave off any cabin fever," said Calloway.

The upcoming show is part of the Blissfest Night on the Town series. Concert ticket holders receive a 10% discount at participating restaurants on the night of the concert.
