Free Heart Screening on National Youth Heart Screening Day

The Heart Screening Clinic is open to students ages 10 to 22 years old, who are not currently under the care of a cardiologist. Echocardiograms will also be offered that day on site, free of charge, for those students who are identified as needing additional testing.

The screening process should take about 45-60 minutes as your child visits our four stations:

- Receive a vitals check including blood pressure, height, and weight.
- Receive an EKG (electrocardiogram) exam.
- Evaluation at the heart sounds/murmur station.
- Learn cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED)
