Family Enrichment Center Relocation

The Plan Commission approved a conditional use permit to relocate the Family Enrichment Center from 885 Badger Circle to 2350 Dakota Drive (former Denta Quest space). The Family Enrichment Center is home to numerous health and human services organizations including Big Brothers Big Sisters of Ozaukee, COPE Services, Habitat for Humanity Ozaukee, Independence First, Interfaith Caregivers of Ozaukee, Mel's Charities, Ozaukee Family Service. The 12,000 square foot space includes offices, conference rooms, restrooms, storage, and a 270-seat event space. The center will be open Monday through Friday 9:00am to 5:00pm. Calibre Collision was approved for the balance of the space in this building in December 2019. The Family Enrichment Center anticipates occupying the space in November 2020.

Small Business Relief Loan Program

On May 18, 2020, the Village Board approved the creation of a Small Business Relief Loan Program out of the existing Revolving Loan Fund. The objective of the program is to assist businesses that had been negatively affected by the COVID-19 crisis. The program was funded with \$125,000 for loans up to \$10,000 per business. Loans have a five year term, with no principle or interest charged in the first year and one percent charged thereafter.
