Port of Milwaukee (25 miles south)

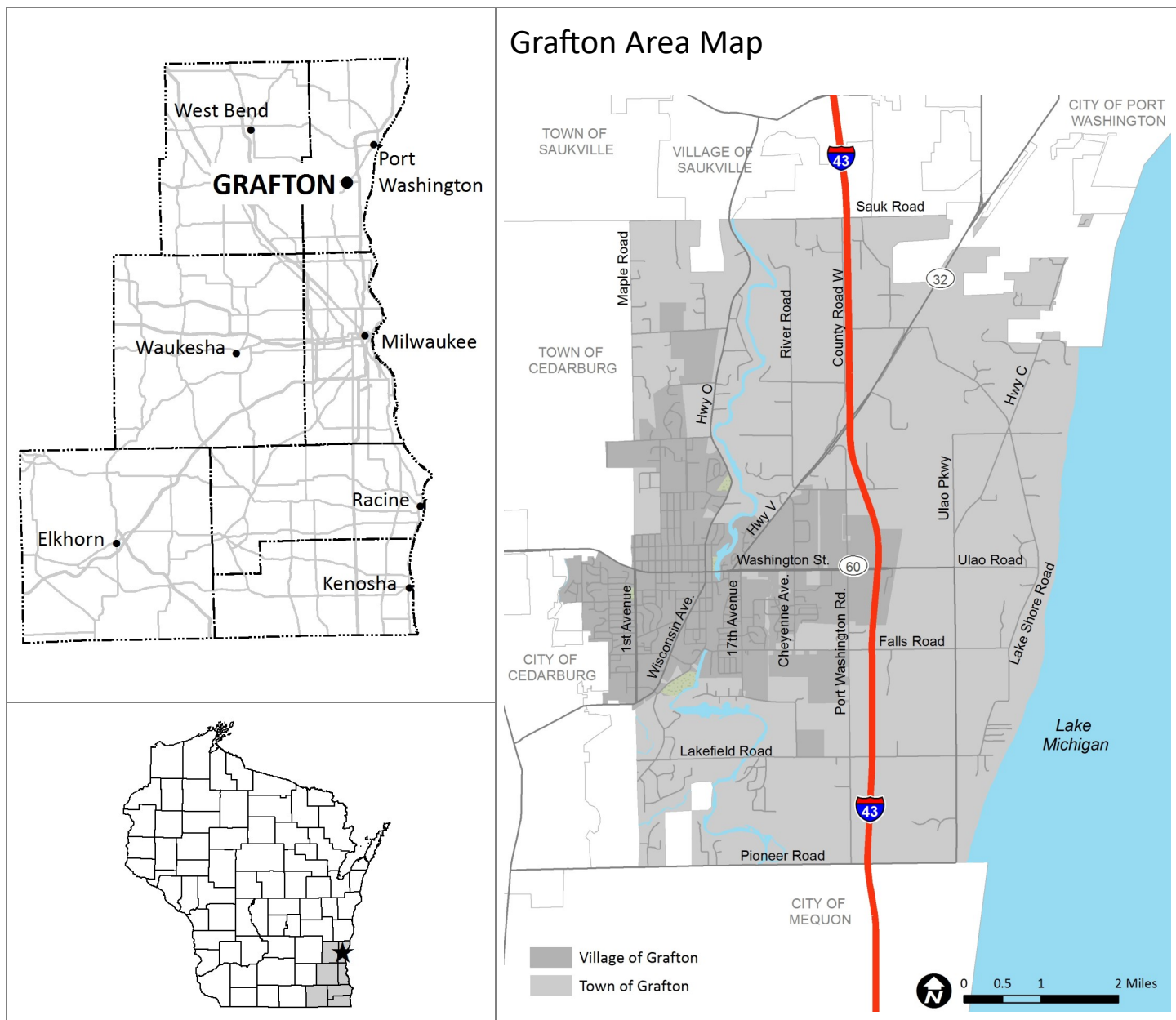
Amenities
