Jennifer Stoddard Hajdu has always been deeply interested in politics. After graduating from SMU Law School in 1991, she joined the Park Cities Republican Women in Dallas. She has held many roles in various organizations, but her most rewarding was being elected Chair of the Dallas County Republican Party. Assembling a talented and focused, she undertook the task of resurrecting a barely recognizable county party—raising funds, building infrastructure, developing strong relationships, and earning the respect of countywide leaders and grassroots members.

During her tenure, she raised nearly \$2 million to support conservative candidates and strengthen resources available to candidates and precinct chairs. She launched a major recruitment effort to staff 350 election locations, increasing the workforce from 300 to more than 1,400, recognizing that the strongest safeguard for election integrity begins with a Republican presence in every voting center. She also served as the Trump campaign attorney in Dallas County.

Since leaving her role as DCRP Chair, she established a unique political action committee, Dallas County Republicans United, which devotes 100% of its funds to recruiting and supporting underfunded local candidates. She was recently elected 1st VP of the Dallas County Council of Republican Women, where she aims to grow and strengthen Republican women's clubs across the county.

A wife, mother, and full-time attorney of 35 years, Jennifer has been married to Mark Hajdu for 30 years. Their daughter, Kate, is a Vanderbilt University Medical School graduate completing her first year of residency at Barnes-Jewish/Washington University Hospital in St. Louis, specializing in orthopedic surgery. Their son, Jack, is an SMU finance graduate living in Dallas. Jennifer remains committed to helping restore Republican strength in Dallas County.
