Monumental Milestones in Togo

Over 99% of Togo has been mapped through the A Church in Every Village, Everywhere (ACHIEVE) strategy.

10,434 OF 10,491 VILLAGES have been surveyed in partnership with the [Coalition of the Willing](#).

Togo joins Nepal as the only other nation in the world to be surveyed at over 99%.

58% of VILLAGES surveyed have no churches or Christians.

This insight allows church planters to aim their ministry toward villages that are untouched.



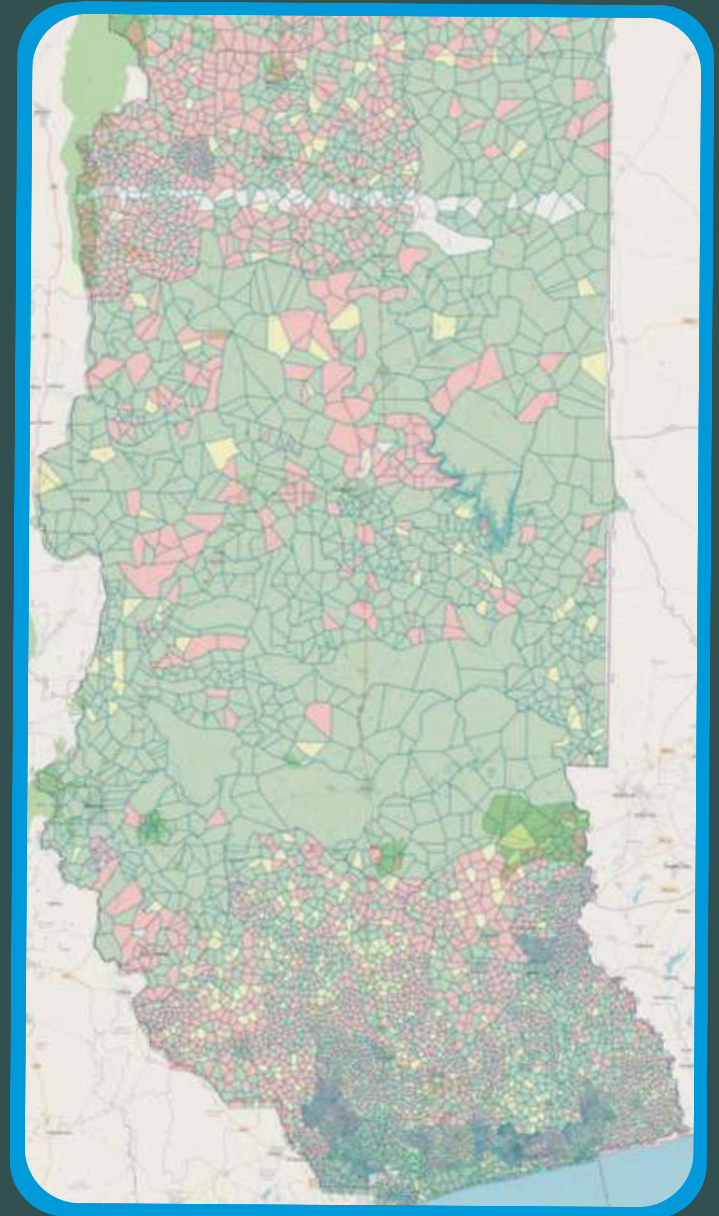
Red villages have no Christians and no churches

Red to Green: ACHIEVE in Togo

210 churches have been planted in red or yellow villages over the last two years.

The vision to see a church planted in every village, everywhere is no small task, but it is gradually being realized in Togo.

Through collaboration with four other organizations, almost the entire country of Togo has been surveyed. Using specialized tools and innovative technology, a digital map was created to show the details of every village, with green zones indicating villages with churches, yellow for areas with believers but no church, and red for those untouched by the Gospel. These surveys are paramount for the missional efforts of TTI's church planters. Every TTI training center set out with the goal of reaching at least 50 villages and made an effort for 50% of their outreach to be aimed at yellow and red villages.

It is beautiful to see the ACHIEVE vision come to life and for red villages to turn green. The first fruits of Togo are inspiring us to dream big and we are expectant to see a church in every village, everywhere.



A Church in Every Village, Everywhere



There is a divine momentum in discipleship and Assou watched with joy as his disciple, Rostand, stepped into his calling as a disciple maker. Rostand had been training under Assou for 18 months, and during that time, he began discipling Eklou and Aga. Carrying the ACHIEVE vision alongside his two disciples, Rostand entered a village that had no churches or Christians present.

These three disciple makers began sharing the gospel door to door. With each door knock, the seed of the Gospel began falling on good soil and the village started coming to life. Right before their eyes, in a village that once had no Christians or churches, a vibrant Christian community began to grow. Many decided to follow Jesus and the Gospel began to multiply through the power of faithful discipleship.

Now, there is a beautiful community of 130 Christ followers and the church is making a powerful impact in the village. A red village has turned green in Togo.

Kodjo and Pierre were gripped by the vision of seeing a church in every village, everywhere. The TTI church planters committed to ministering in villages with no Christian presence. Filled with faith, they knocked door to door, sharing the Gospel of Jesus. Kodjo and Pierre faced consistent rejection and challenge. There was clear opposition to the Gospel but they continued with unwavering faith to see a church planted.

God blessed their labor and a church was planted in an unreached village in southern Togo. By God's grace, the church has grown and is becoming a lifeline for the community.

Kodjo and Pierre's willingness to count the cost and face rejection for the sake of the Gospel has resulted in incredible fruit. A church exists and a village is now green because of their response to the Great Commission.

Alou grew up in a community devoted to ancestral worship and voodoo. Alongside his community, he fasted for months at a time and played the drums during trance rituals. Despite his devotion, the peace that Alou was searching for remained elusive.

Last year, he met a TTI church planter named Raymond who was teaching about the "victorious Christian life." Raymond's words stirred hope in his heart and he considered following Jesus. Alou feared the spirits he served and the retaliation he might experience for becoming a Christian. Raymond assured Alou that the love of Jesus was stronger than any spirit and that God would protect him. With these words settling his heart, he decided to follow Jesus and joined Raymond's church. Now, Alou's drumbeats are inspiring worship within his local church. Alou was born again as a worshipper of the One True Living God.

Resurrection Life

Tilati's life changed forever a few months ago. Tilati left her children with their grandmother as she journeyed out to fetch water for the family. The one kilometer trek was just like she remembered: mundane and tiring. When she returned, the unthinkable unfolded. She found her son, Eli, lying motionless and limp on the ground in her house. He was unresponsive and she didn't know what to do.

Cradling her lifeless child, Tilati frantically considered who she could turn to for help. In desperation she ran in the direction of Sato, a TTI disciple maker who had often shared about Jesus Christ's teachings and power. As she ran, despair filled her heart and she began to weep. When she arrived, through tears and broken breaths, she begged for help. Sato quickly understood the dire need of the situation and carried Eli inside. Sato was overwhelmed with the compassion of Jesus and fervently prayed for God's healing power to interrupt the tragedy. Eli's body remained lifeless for the minutes that followed. Tilati retreated outside, weeping and overcome by fear and grief. A miracle unfolded as Sato continued to pray, Eli's body stirred, he took a breath, and his eyes opened. Life returned to the young child and Tilati's wails of sorrow turned to tears of joy as she came back inside. After witnessing the power of God, Tilati picked up her son and hugged him tightly.

God's resurrection power did more than raise Eli from the dead; it also resurrected Tilati's spiritual life. This miracle was a turning point in her life and she completely surrendered to Jesus. Tilati attends Sato's church and often shares this testimony. Many in the community have been drawn in by this fascinating story and are marveling at the power of Jesus Christ because of it.

Toutou was born into an idol worshipping family. From a young age, she was taught about the spirits and she devoted her life to appeasing them. Although she was a woman of faith, there was a heavy shadow of despair that followed her day to day. This pain was too heavy to carry on her own and she often visited witchdoctors looking for a solution. Toutou gave all she had to the witchdoctors but still left feeling empty and hopeless.

Kekeli, a friend and former devout Muslim, visited Toutou one day. Kekeli, a TTI disciple maker, shared how she encountered Jesus and was miraculously healed. This story of the power and love of Jesus in action deeply impacted Toutou. Initially, she was skeptical, but she decided to press in and seek more answers.

Shortly after this visit, Toutou joined Kekeli at her church. Toutou's heart softened and she felt her burdens lift for the first time as she was surrounded by so much warmth and love. Toutou confessed Jesus Christ as Savior and is now being discipled by Kekeli. The Gospel is the power of God to save and both Toutou and Kekeli have experienced this reality firsthand. Together, they are pursuing those around them with the Gospel and seeing once-red villages turn green.

There are around 6,000 red or yellow villages in Togo. Pray that by the end of 2025 we can see that number drop below 4,000 villages.

The harvest is ripe but the laborers are few. Pray that the Vision Casting meetings across Togo will be effective in inspiring more Gospel workers.

Pray that as multiple ministries join together with the ACHIEVE vision that there would be supernatural unity and effectiveness.
