Course overview

Join Kathy Heicher from the Eagle County Historical Society (ECHS) for a general overview of Eagle County history from Ute tribal history to the development of the Vail ski resort. The class will include a PowerPoint slide show featuring photos from the ECHS archives, followed by either a walking tour of Eagle or a tour of the Chambers' Park Local Historical Museum.

Kathy Heicher will provide the narrative, including anecdotes and details on the history of the county. Questions from the audience are encouraged. Participants come away with historical information about each of the valley's communities.
