### Education

#### A. Community

- Library display (Dawn) – Created lobby display case for Trashion Show Call for Artists
- Downtown Bigbelly signage (Jane) – Created new signage to change tossing behavior in order to decrease contamination in the recycling
- Multifamily recycling contamination improvement (Diane)
  - > Got new labeled tops for recycling toters at Winslow Manor from Bainbridge Disposal and posted “Do not bag recyclables” to eliminate plastic bags in recycling
  - > Provided Kitsap recycling and yard waste pamphlets to Jacolet condos point person and recycling pamphlets to Bainbridge Senior Living management

- Land Trust Potluck (Regina, Diane) **January** – Set up and monitored discard station for ~200 guests
- Chilly Hilly (Susan, Judy and 5 volunteers) **February** - Set up and monitored discard station for ~500 riders
- Trashion Show (Naomi) **August** – Organized display of five outfits in Bainbridge Arts & Crafts window
- Styrofoam Recycling and CD Recycling Collection (steering committee and 50+ volunteers) **September** – 448 cars, 3 semi-trailers filled and collected ~2700 disks

#### Public Services
