OVERVIEW

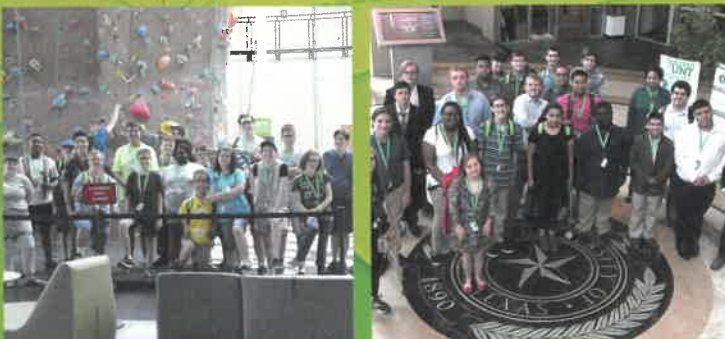
