The National Day of Repentance and Solemn Assemblies Prayer Points for the Mississippi Case at the Supreme Court Nov. 30 - Dec. 2, 2021

On Wednesday, December 1, 2021, The Supreme Court will be hearing the Oral Argument in the Mississippi Ban on Late Term Abortion Case, Dobbs. The law will ban late term abortions after 15-weeks. This is the best opportunity since 1992 to see the reversal of Roe v. Wade and end legalized abortion in our country. We believe we should come together to pray the day before, the day of, and the day after Oral Argument. The final decision on this case will probably be announced by the Supreme Court in June 2022, so we must continue to pray even after this three-day event.

Here are some prayer points:

1. Pray for the Supreme Court Justices. <u>Leviticus 19:15</u> over each Justice by name.

- 2. Pray for the Mississippi Attorney General's Office. Psalms 91, Isaiah 11:12
 - a. Pray for Mississippi's Attorney General, Lynn Fitch and Mississippi's Solicitor General who will be arguing the case, Scott Stewart. Pray for the Mississippi's Empowering Women Rally in front of the Supreme Court during Oral Argument
- 3. Pray for the ending of abortion. <u>Isaiah 28:14-22</u>
 - a. Repenting for the millions of lives that have been aborted since 1973.
 - b. Pray for confusion, frustration and cancellation of Satan's plans and binding of the spiritual forces of wickedness. Plead the Blood of Jesus against the enemy and his plans.
- 4. Pray for the National Day of Repentance Team for safety, protection, traveling mercies, order and perfect peace in all that they do. Pray that God would prosper the work of their hands. Psalms 27, Psalms 90:16-17
- 5. Pray for the 40-hour prayer broadcast, for the people operating the broadcast, for protection of the airwaves, for the Holy Spirit to release true repentance to the viewers and hearers without any hindrances. Psalms 34:7, Psalms 121:7, Ephesians 6:10-18
- 6. Pray for God's protection over the event at the MLK and Lincoln Memorial, and at the Supreme Court event. Pray that He release His order and rebuke the enemy from attacking these events. <u>II Thess. 3:3</u>, <u>Isaiah 54:17</u>, <u>Psalms 18:35-36</u>
 - a. Abraham Lincoln was not just fighting against slavery and Martin Luther King Jr. was not just fighting against segregation. Both of these great men criticized two Supreme Court decisions that allowed slavery and segregation. (Sanford v. Dredd Scott and Brown v. Board of Education). The Supreme Court eventually overturned both decisions and we pray for the same for legalized abortion.
- 7. Pray for all the legal teams and their clients who have filed briefs standing for Life. Pray that their voices be heard and pray for their protection from the backlash of the enemy. Isaiah 41:10, Psalms 32:7, Hebrews 13:6
- 8. Pray for the message of repentance to move upon the body of Christ in America.
 - a. Repent for our country's sexual immorality, the innocent shedding of blood, forsaking God and His covenants, and for the love of money. <u>II Corinithians 7:10</u>, II Chronicles 7:13-15, I Timothy 6:10
- 9. Pray for the salvation of every human who has participated in abortion, who supports abortion, or who works in the abortion industry.
 - a. God can save anyone and desires to bless them with salvation and healing. Many have come out of the abortion industry such as Norma McCorvey, the "Roe" of Roe v. Wade; Dr. Bernard Nathanson, the Founder of the National Abortion Rights Action League; Abby Johnson, Planned Parenthood Clinic Director and Employee of the Year; Dr. Anthony Lepanto, abortionist; and many, many more.
