



**Baltimore County 2019 Scholarship
Application
Deadline April 26, 2019**
(Applications **MUST** be received by Baltimore County
Farm Bureau 4:00 p.m. April 26, 2019.)

Baltimore County Farm Bureau may offer up to three \$2,500 scholarships annually. Applicants must be at least high school seniors starting college in the fall of 2019 or full-time college students at any community college or four-year institution. Applicants or their parents/guardians **MUST** be members of Baltimore County Farm Bureau. Two of the scholarships will be offered to students majoring in an agricultural curriculum and one scholarship will be offered to a student majoring in any curriculum.

The application review will include assessment of a two-page essay as well as responses to general questions about yourself including academic achievement, post graduate plans, involvement in agriculture and community service, and leadership experience.

Scholarship payments will be issued to the selected applicant's educational institution upon receipt of a letter of acknowledgment and acceptance from the recipient within 30 days of official notification.

Selection will be made by a committee designated by the Baltimore County Farm Bureau Board of Directors. This committee will evaluate each application anonymously and the committee may not include any person related to an applicant. No student may receive this scholarship more than four times.

To apply, students must return the attached application and their **unsigned** essay (unsigned means NO identifying information. For example, no college names, no 4-H club names, no town names, no county names, etc.). The essay should be two pages, utilizing 12-point font.

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. Please be sure to include correct contact information for your references.

Scholarship will be announced before the close of the 2019 school year. Winners and their families will be invited to attend the Baltimore County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting. The committee reserves the right to interview scholarship applicants and will contact references.
