
The Baltimore County Farm Bureau Distinguished Service Award

Rules & Qualifications

1. The Baltimore County Farm Bureau's award for distinguished service is given in recognition of outstanding service in the interest of Farm Bureau and agriculture.



- 3. Nominees must be Baltimore County Farm Bureau members who have contributed to the betterment of the organization and the industry at the county, state, or national level.
- 4. The nomination should include name, address, phone number, and qualifications for the nominee and the individual nominating.
- 5. Award winners will be selected only from nominations made in the current year. However, nominations made in previous years may be resubmitted.
- 6. This award may be awarded once per year during the annual banquet as qualified recipients are identified.

The Baltimore County Farm Bureau Distinguished Service Award applications shall be judged by a panel to consist of two previous BCFB presidents and the MFB field staff representative for Baltimore County.
