

SUMMER CAMP UPDATE:

In addition to the procedures listed above, the following policies are in effect for the duration of our 2020 summer camps:

- Preschool/rising K campers will meet at the FRONT DOOR (keeping appropriate distance) each morning and will be dismissed via the front door at noon.
- Rising 1st-5th campers will meet at the BACK DOOR (keeping appropriate distance) each morning and will be dismissed via the back door at noon.
- Campers may NOT bring in any water bottles, snacks or other personal items **unless previously approved by Miss Lisa**. (We recognize some of our campers have medical needs/food sensitivities and will accommodate you within our capabilities).
- If anyone other than the adult listed on your registration form will be picking up your child, we must have their name and cell number on file.

**PROCEDURES FOR RE-OPENING
AMID PHASE 2 OF COVID-19 QUARANTINE
EFFECTIVE MAY 26, 2020**

Thank you for your confidence and trust in us as we re-open our facility. To ensure the safety of both students and faculty, the following procedures must be adhered to. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in your child not being admitted for tutoring.

- Parent/guardian and student will remain in their car or outside at acceptable distance from others entering/exiting BRA or the dentists near us.
- Your child's tutor will greet you OUTSIDE and escort their student in the building. **NO ONE OTHER THAN THE STUDENT AND TUTOR ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING AT THIS TIME.**
- At the end of the lesson, the tutor will bring your child to you either directly to your car, or to you waiting outside.
- Masks are worn at the discretion of tutor/student.
- Students will use hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the building.

We will be sanitizing work space and materials between students. Please do not send in anything from home with your student unless it has been pre-approved by Miss Lisa.
