Candidates are required to have 35 valid signatures from residents in their respective ward.

The deadline to turn nomination papers in is September 7<sup>th</sup> by 4:00 p.m.

### **The November ballot will have several Charter Amendments for residents to vote on as follows:**

- Charter Amendment #1 – Staggered three-year council terms
- Charter Amendment #2 - Mayor presides over both the City Council and School Board
- Charter Amendment #3 – Revision of necessary departments
- Charter Amendment #4 - Clarification on publishing notice for public hearing on the budget
- Charter Amendment #5 - Gender neutrality throughout Charter

On September 4<sup>th</sup> the City Council will also be reviewing another potential Charter Amendment as follows:

- Charter Amendment #6 – Regular budget meetings between City Council and School Board
