SHELTERS

ChristNet Nighttime Shelter Program

Description: Provides overnight shelter to the homeless from mid-October - the end of May.

Intake: Call 734-287-8890 between 7am-10am to see if beds are available.

ChristNet Daytime Program

Description: Helps to connect homeless individuals with available services and resources.

Intake: Call 734-287-8890 or walk-in for intake. Open 6am-5pm. Location same as above.

Lighthouse Mission

Description: Provides overnight shelter the homeless. Open from January 1st-March 31st.

Intake: Walk-in for assistance. Phone number is 734-326-3885.

Samaritas Family Center Westland

Description: Offers year-round emergency shelter for homeless families.

Description: Transitional housing program for homeless veterans
