Learn more about the legacy of
Louis I Kahn

Kahn described his buildings as "ruins in reverse," and was inspired by the inherent qualities of materials in his designs. One of his most famous quotes narrates: "You say to a brick, 'What do you want, brick?' And brick says to you, 'I like an arch.' And you say to brick, 'Look, I want one, too, but arches are expensive and I can use a concrete lintel.' And then you say: 'What do you think of that, brick?' Brick says: I like an arch."

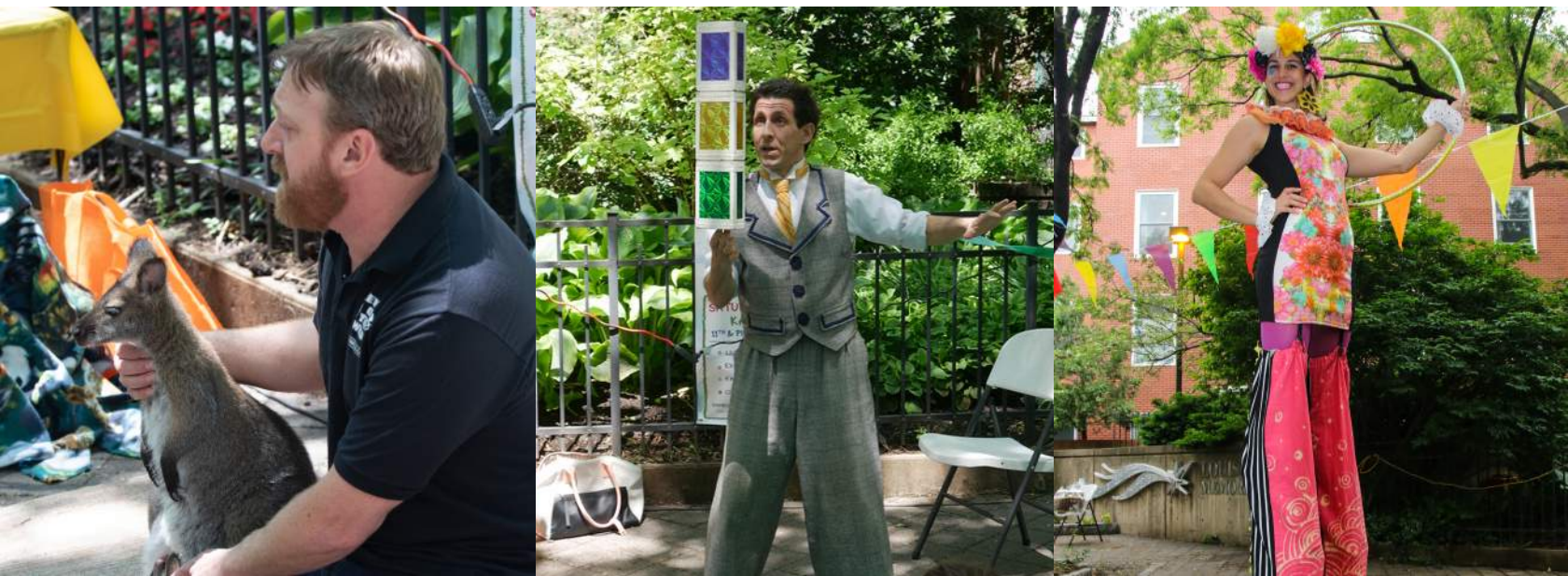
