


2018 Chancellor A. Charles Baillie Teaching Award



Established in 2003 through gifts from the Toronto Dominion Bank and Chancellor Emeritus Charles Baillie, the Chancellor A. Charles Baillie Teaching Award recognizes undergraduate or graduate teaching or professional teaching that has had an outstanding influence on the quality of student learning at Queen's University. It is awarded annually for activities that lead to improved learning, including curriculum development, educational leadership, design and delivery of out-of-classroom educational experiences, or classroom teaching and supervision.

The recipient of this monetary award will receive the money as part of their Queen's monthly pay, normally during the pay period when the Award is received. The recipient of the award is formally acknowledged during the fall convocation. Faculty may be nominated by a peer or academic administrator, or may self-nominate.
