The conditions of appointment as a Visiting Professor of Canadian Studies at Kwansei Gakuin University are as follows:

**Term of Appointment** 

Four-month appointment: Fall (20 September 2021 – 19 January 2022)

(Possible to arrange the fall semester period as from 20 September 2021 until 31 December 2021 if necessary arrangements including providing a makeup class are completed.)

Responsibilities

Responsibilities include: teaching two 90-minute courses per week; e.g. teaching an undergraduate course and a graduate course, or two undergraduate courses, or two graduate courses on some aspect(s) of contemporary Canada in either English, French or Japanese. The Visiting Professor is also expected to contribute several lectures to the university-wide integrated Canadian Studies Courses, Canadian Studies Seminar (planning, lectures, advice to students), some faculty seminars and lectures, and/or advise students in their research. The successful applicant will be expected to contribute to the development of Canadian Studies in Japan.

## Qualifications

Canadian citizen or landed immigrant; holder of a full-time teaching position at a Canadian University. Applicants either from Kwansei Gakuin University's partner institutions (University of Toronto, Queen's University, Mount Allison University, McGill University, University of British Columbia, Simon Fraser University, University of Victoria, University of Waterloo, Huron University College at Western University, King's University College at Western University, University of Calgary, Memorial University of Newfoundland, University of Guelph and Trent University) or those who have a recommendation from a full-time faculty member at Kwansei Gakuin University will be prioritized. Clear evidence of both research and teaching experience in Canadian topics and possession of a Doctorate are preferred.

**Fields of Teaching** 

Theology, religion, philosophy, arts, education, geography, history, literature, linguistics, psychology, social psychology, sociology, cultural anthropology, social welfare, social work, journalism, political science, public administration, international relations, law, criminology and penology, economics, business administration, policy studies (human ecology, urban affairs, international development, environmental management, social policy) and international studies (North American studies and Asian studies).

## Remuneration

Monthly: ¥670,000 (before tax, will be adjusted according to the period of stay) for professor, associate professor, assistant professor or equivalent.

Additional remuneration will be given for teaching more than two courses.

Travel costs to and from Japan and furnished housing (at a rent of \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{10,000}\) per month excluding utilities) will be provided. The costs of a courtesy visit to the Canadian Embassy, Tokyo and of participation in the Annual Conference of the Japanese Association of Canadian Studies will also be covered.
