We are writing this letter to share with you a decision made by the MLC Council at our December meeting.

As the Council, we have been looking at the work being done by each and every one of our staff members. We were struck by each person's commitment and passion for the ministry that God has given them at Messiah. They have responded with creativity and energy to meet the needs of the church and broader community during the COVID closure. It has been relentless and demanding work.

In recognition of this, Council voted to provide time for staff to unplug, reflect, and recharge by suspending all Messiah operations and granting our staff two weeks of additional paid leave from Monday, February 1 – Friday, February 12. During that time, the office will be closed. Additionally, we will not have our usual Facebook Live worship services. Instead, these services will be pre-recorded and posted on our website.

The office will be closed beginning February 1 and will reopen on February 15.
