### **Assessing Readiness for CAVs training description:**

This course is intended for transportation professionals/agencies that are already familiar with introductory connected and automated (CAV) concepts and are beginning to plan implementation of CAV environment. The overall goal of this course is to teach participants how to develop an action plan in collaboration with regional partners to improve readiness for CAV deployment. Participants will learn more about the technological components required for CAVs, the hardware/software being deployed at the CV Pilot sites, and overall lessons learned from the design/build/test phase of the three pilots. Lastly, they will be made aware of recent activities supported by the ITS Joint Program Office and resources available from the CV research program sponsored by the U.S.DOT. This course is an overhauled version of the CV201 class ITSA and USDOT offered earlier.
