

## Dear Presbytery —

The PTCA Nominating Committee has been actively working to improve how we identify interested persons from our faith communities and match their spiritual gifts to help us grow and lead our Presbytery to make a difference in the world.

It is our desire to support the Moderator's vision for the presbytery and help to assure that each of the 59 faith communities are connected to others within the presbytery as well as continuing to develop and support tomorrow's leaders, and building upon the spiritual gifts of the estimated 14,000 members of those 59 faith communities. Romans 12:3-8 tells us to give humble service in the body of Christ, stating:

*"For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of yourself more highly than you ought to think, but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned. For as in one body we have many members, and not all the members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another. We have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us: prophecy, in proportion to faith; ministry, in ministering; the teacher, in teaching; the exhorter, in exhortation; the giver, in generosity; the leader, in diligence; the compassionate, in cheerfulness."*
