

It's time to apply to be a General Assembly commissioner

Applications are now being accepted for the 223rd General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) slated next summer, June 16-23, in St. Louis. The Presbytery of the Twin Cities Area will send two ruling elders and two teaching elders as commissioners, and a young adult advisory delegate -- age 17-23.

The application deadline is Sept. 15.

General Assembly commissioners and delegates are required to attend an orientation session, be present for the entire Assembly and be available to interpret the activities of the Assembly to congregations and the presbytery.

All expenses are paid by the Office of the General Assembly -- per capita dollars at work.
