Goals

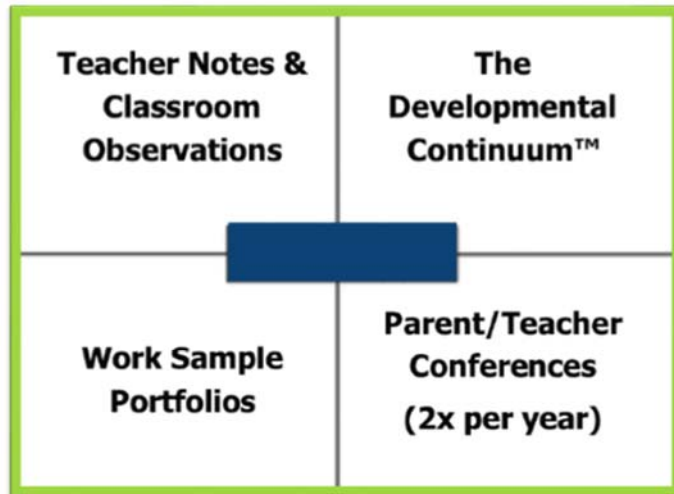
- To provide a safe and stimulating environment that nurtures the natural wonder in each child.

School-Year Fees

REGISTRATION: \$75/CHILD

FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT: \$100/CHILD

SUPPLY FEE: \$40/CHILD (\$80/family maximum)

Due to limited storage space, we are unable to house donated school supplies. The supply fee provides classroom consumable/art supplies to be purchased as needed throughout the year.

Vacation Policy

(Inclusive tuition rates only)

We believe that family-time is a priority and it is important for children to spend holiday and vacation time with their families.

- Two (2) weeks of vacation per year between September and May may be taken using a Vacation Voucher in place of paying the family's weekly tuition rate.
- Vacations must be taken in blocks of one (1) week at a time. Vouchers have the value of one week's tuition.

Schedule Policies

School Year Schedule:

- \$25/Schedule Update Processing Fee per child will be applied to any school year schedule change received after confirmation.
- ALL 3 Day schedules MUST include a Monday or Friday.
- Kinderstart Students MUST attend 3 or more classes/week. (ie: minimum of 3 half days or 1 half/1 full day)

Summer WOW Schedule:

- THREE UPDATES ALLOWED: \$25/Schedule Update Processing Fee per child will be applied to summer schedule changes received after confirmation.
- ALL 3 Day schedules MUST include a Monday or Friday.

Drop-Off / Pick-Up Time Updates:

- Changes to Drop-Off/Pick-Up Times must be confirmed with the Site-Director and/or Admissions.



Program Options

Discovery Classes: 3 yrs. by Sept. 1

Watch out world! Three year olds are taking on new challenges every day. New thoughts and ideas are being formed, along with new words and friendships. **Discovery Lead Teachers have a four-year degree in pre-primary/early-elementary education with a MN Teaching License.** They plan engaging, hands-on lessons that guide children's learning. Children are developing skills, including preparing for future reading and math skills. **PM Classes are taught by the Site Lead Teaching Team.**

PM Half-Day Class Party Days & Fieldtrips are combined with the AM Class. PM Only students attend AM FREE in addition to the regular schedule.

Kinderstart Classes: 4 yrs. by Sept. 1

Preparing for success! Four year olds are ready for the continued academic and social challenges before them. Language and critical-thinking are in rapid growth. They are starting to think logically and can use language to express their thinking. They are eager to explore and learn more about the world. **Kinderstart Lead Teachers have a four-year degree in pre-primary/early-elementary education with a MN Teaching License.** They plan and lead lessons full of hands-on activities and experiences that encourage discovery through play. The classroom and lessons engage learners' imaginations and allow children to discover new concepts with confidence. **PM Classes are taught by the Site Lead Teaching Team.** *PM Half-Day Class Party Days and Fieldtrips are combined with the AM Class. PM Only students attend AM FREE in addition to their regular schedule.*

Kinderstart students must enroll for 3 or more core-classes/week. We believe this is the minimal schedule to give teachers the time to assess a child's academic, social and self-help skills for kindergarten-readiness assessments.

Explorer Classes: 16 mos. by Sept. 1

Toddlers are on the move! They are exploring and learning through play; growing more confident every day. Language and relationships, along with fine and large motor skills are developing by leaps and bounds. **Explorer Lead Teachers have a two-year degree in Child-Development or a four-year degree in a related field.** The morning core class is full of fun and hands-on activities that help toddler learners develop cognitive, emotional, social and physical skills, providing important building-blocks for future learning success.

Wrap-Around Care: Multi-age

The **Extended Adventure Program (EAP)** provides a warm and relaxed environment, where children can play with friends, and continue to learn while having fun. While attending before school, children are served breakfast between 7:00-8:00 AM. After school, children have the opportunity for additional large muscle time, creative activities and games, as well as downtime as needed. Snack is served at 4:30 PM.

Summer W.O.W Program: Multi-age

(Summer 2019 hosted by Faith Lutheran / Summer 2020 open at Hosanna)
The **World Of Wonder Summer Camps** offer fun experiences and exciting activities for enrolled children through weekly Bible-themed camps. Children strengthen friendships while exploring Bible Stories, science experiments, outdoor play and bi-monthly fieldtrips; in-house and bussed.
