2023 Parent/Caregiver Survey Results

152 responses were gathered from United Way's "Read to Me" Survey, helping measure the impact of Dolly Parton's Imagination Library program on Hernando preschool children, birth to age 5.

77%

of caregivers believe that by receiving free, high quality & age appropriate books every month it has enhanced their child's early learning and literacy skills!

27% of responses are from families of children who have been enrolled less than a year on the Program.

- 10-20 Minutes (36.84%)
- 20-30 Minutes (30.26%)
- 30-60+ Minutes (13.82%)


Top identified barriers to reading for 20 minutes every day:

- Child gets easily distracted (short attention span, etc)
- Busy schedules (siblings, school activities, work, etc.)
- Finding unique ways to engage special needs children with story time

*Please note these percentages ONLY represent 2023 survey responses submitted and is not the total representation of actual preschool children enrolled




- Asian (2.63%)
