*\*Beginning April 5, 2021, 16 and 17 year olds will have access to the COVID-19 vaccine, however the ONLY vaccine approved for 16 and 17 year olds is the Pfizer vaccine (Pfizer-BioNTech.) The health department does **NOT** carry the Pfizer vaccine and will not accommodate anyone under the age of 18 for a COVID-19 vaccine.*
