General Dress Code Policy

Dining Rooms

(Dogwood & Redbud)

Country Club Casual

Gentlemen: Slacks, dress denim (without holes, tears, or patches), and dress shorts are acceptable. Men must wear collared shirts or tasteful collarless shirts, turtlenecks, or mock turtlenecks. Gentlemen are asked to remove their hats in the dining room.

Ladies: Slacks, dress denim (without holes, tears, or patches), shorts, capri pants, skirts, dresses, and blouses are acceptable.

Upper Deck

Breakfast & Lunch

Country Club casual attire, and golf attire, including golf shoes and hats, are allowed. Tennis, exercise attire, and swimwear with a cover-up are acceptable.

Footwear must be worn.

Dinner

Country club casual as defined for dining rooms.
